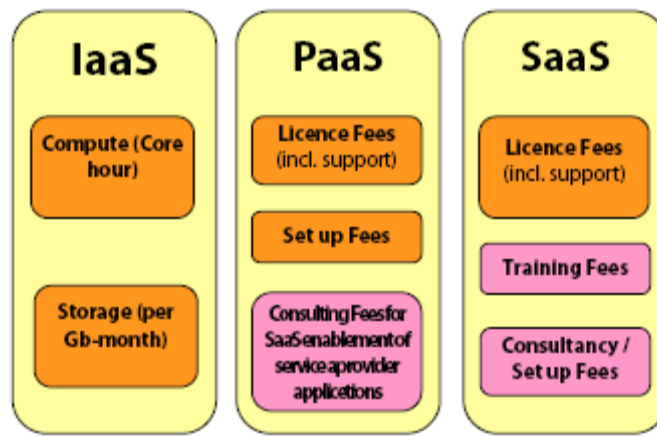

Enhanced Productivity and Innovation Credit (PIC) Scheme

Amongst the enhancements to the Productivity and Innovation Credit (PIC) Scheme has been announced in Budget 2012 are the following –

- Where taxpayer selects the Cash Payout Option, the cash payout for Year of Assessment 2013 to 2015 has been increased from 30% to 60% of qualifying expenditure
- Qualifying expenditure for "Acquisition or Leasing of PIC Automation Equipment" now includes "Cloud computing payment". Payments that will be considered as "Cloud computing payment" are –



- Non-certified in-house training courses, subject to an expenditure cap of \$10,000 per year of assessment can now qualify under the PIC Scheme.
